3,000 hours of pro and low bono legal services

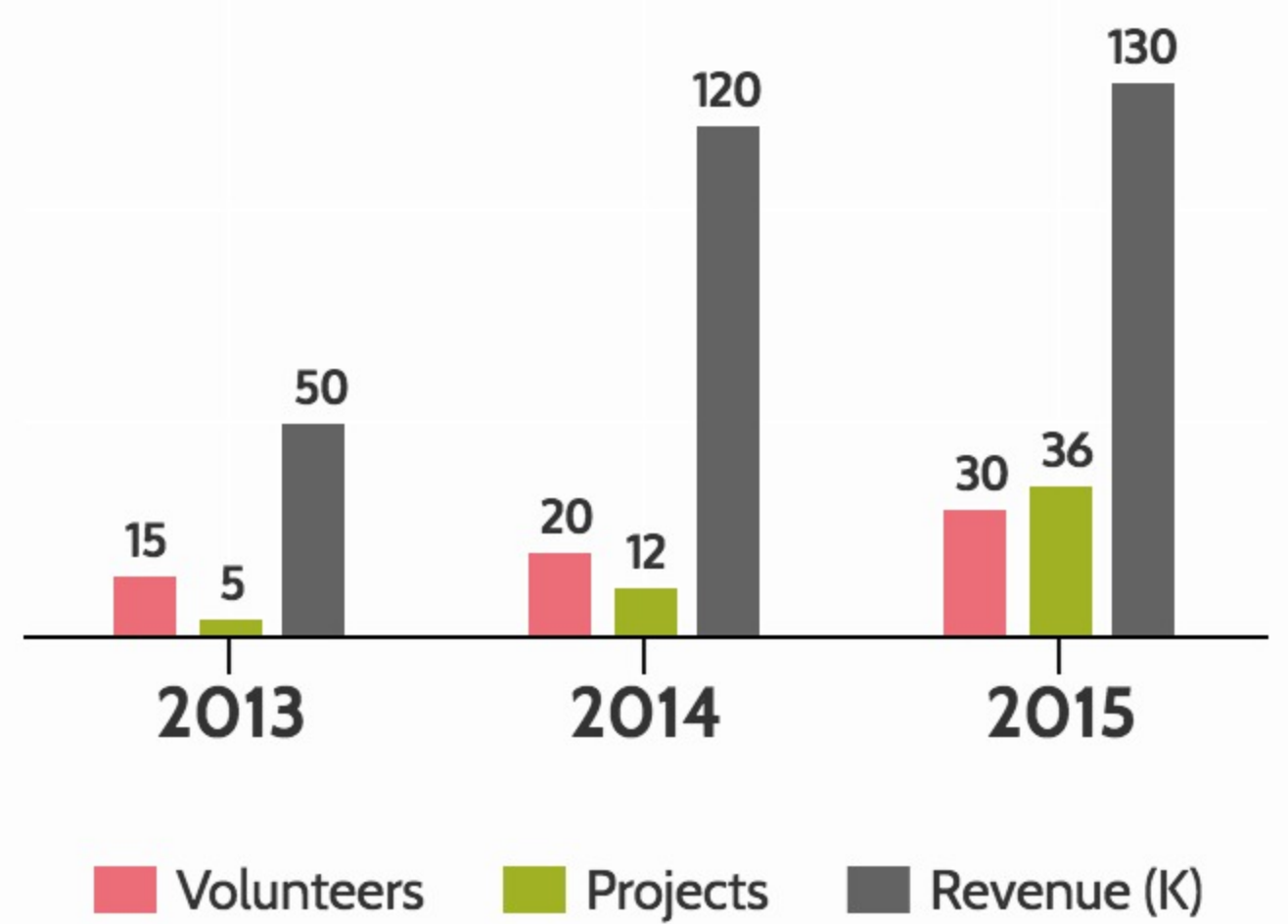

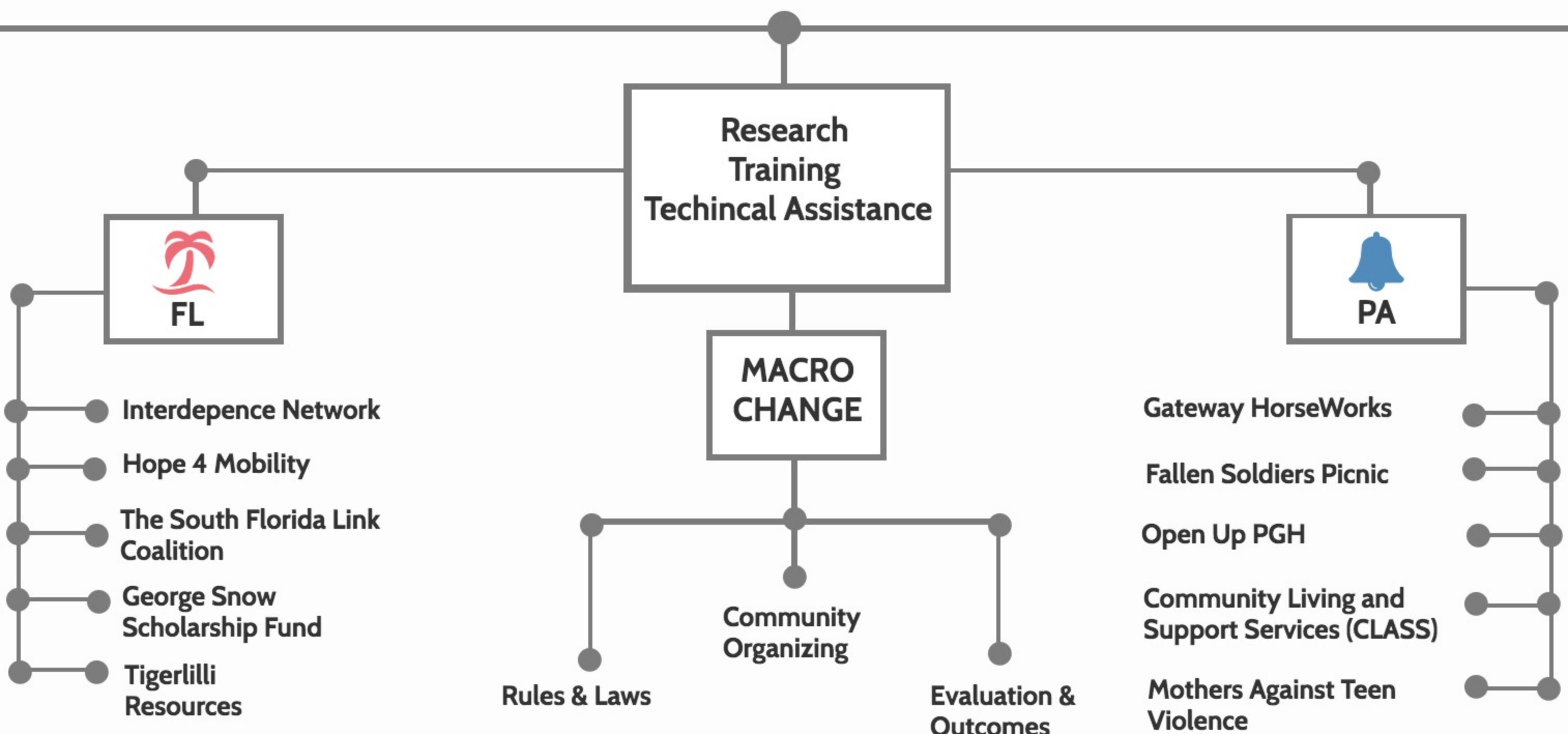
